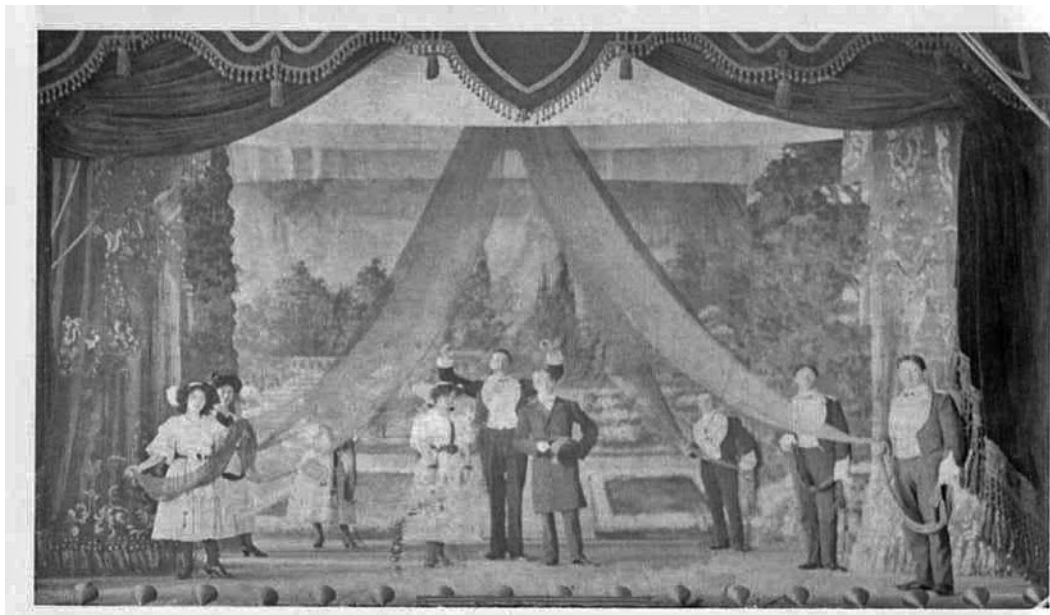


Pierrots & Variety Photo Album



While his Geishas continued entertaining on the Harbour Green Harry Marvello expanded his enterprises. He bought the Tower Hotel, the castellated mansion at the foot of what is now Figgate Street and built the Tower Pavilion in its ground fronting the Promenade where he presented variety shows and early films.



This photograph was taken in the theatre on the last night of the 1907 summer show and records on the reverse that, “a large number of presents were given ... Tom Packer was presented with a cabbage decorated with flowers. Sorry show over.”
